IN HOUSE CHARGES by Hartley O'Brien Parsons Thompson & Hill to clients

Photocopies	.25 per page
Fax transmissions	1.00 per page
Postage	actual cost of the postage to the lawyers
Long distance telephone	actual charge by the long distance carrier to the lawyers
Mileage	34.5¢ per mile for auto travel. All auto travel is measured from the court in which the case is filed or will be filed, or from Wheeling, West Virginia, whichever is shorter.

OUTSIDE SERVICE CHARGES

An outside service charge is the price paid by the lawyers for services provided by others for the benefit of the case. All of the outside services needed in any particular case cannot be predicted, because of the variable requirements from case-to-case. The list below illustrates the types of outside services which are typically needed, but your case might not require all of them, and it will probably require services which are not listed.

Your case will be charged with exactly what the attorneys are required to pay for outside services.

Typical outside expenses

- ◆ Fees of expert witnesses.
- ◆ Court reporter and videographer fees for depositions.
- ◆ Travel expenses for your lawyers, such as airfare, hotel, meals, taxes for travels in connection with your case.
- ◆ Express shipping (FedEx, UPS, etc.)
- ◆ Consultants who will not be expert witnesses in the case, such as jury consultants, audio-visual consultants, computer consultants, and medical records consultants.
- ◆ Court filing fee.
- ◆ Specialized on-line computer research.
